The Governing Body of the college is the apex body of making policy decisions and defining procedures under the chairmanship of Collector and the District Magistrate of Sambalpur. Principal is the secretary with local MP, MLA, and others having academic, industry and administrative experience as members.

Principal is the head of the institution who is vested with the power and authority to supervise, control and monitor all administrative and academic matters of the college.

Administration Bursar of the college is entrusted with the responsibility of supervising all the official activities of the ministerial staff.

The Accounts Bursar is the head of the Accounts section. He is responsible for the disbursement of salary and other financial matters of the employees.

The senior faculty member of the department acts as the HOD who co-ordinates the departmental works.

The college has a well-functioning parents teachers association (PTA) wherein the welfare of the students and the institution are discussed.

The non-teaching staff of the college play a vital role for the smooth functioning of the office, laboratories and the library of the college. There are various sections in the office like Admission, Accounts, Examination, establishment etc. The Head Clerk supervises all the activities of the office.

Staff council is the official body comprising of all the teachers of the college. Here decisions relating to college administration, admission, examination and important instructions from the government are discussed thread bare before taking the final decision.
