
Programme officer smt Monashree Panigrahi presented the annual report and with ppt and placed the annual activity report.

World Environment Day



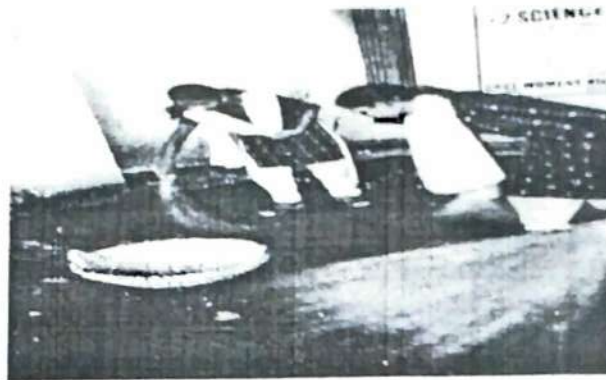
Report of the Swachhata Abhijan on the occasion of celebration of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, Father of Nation






