










Proceedings of the IQAC Meeting


The following resolutions were adopted in the meeting:

PROCEEDINGS OF THE IQAC MEETING

The fourth meeting of IQAC was held on Dt. 16.03.2017 at 11:30 AM in the New Smart Room to discuss the plan proposal of the IDP (Institutional Development Project). At the outset, the Principal Smt. S.S. Tripathy welcomed the members and briefed the purpose of the meeting. Dr. U.S. Dash, The Administrative Bursar, gave an introduction regarding the World Bank Assisted Programme (IDP) and sought suggestion from the Hon'ble members for incorporation of additional details in the plan proposal which was already presented before the Governing Body meeting.

Dr. K. Rath, Asst. coordinator, IDP gave a power point presentation regarding the detailed plan proposal of the college and explained the objective and requirements of the college point by point before the Hon'ble members.

The following suggestions were given in the meeting:

1. It was suggested to strengthen the Computer Lab. and to re-construct the Playground of the college.
2. A Student Activity Centre will be opened where the different activities of the students will be conducted for the benefit of the students.
3. A Beautician Course will be opened in the college. Odisha State Open University, Sambalpur may be requested to give Certificate or Diploma to the students for this course.
4. Dr. A. Prusty suggested opening of a Carrier Junction involving management body from the local Industry.
5. Dr. S.K. Dash, DLC Sambalpur suggested for developing awareness regarding conservation of forest and bio-diversity. He also suggested for a tribal study centre which will develop awareness for developing awareness of tribal culture and conservation of forest.
6. Sri R.N. Mishra suggested to make awareness programme in the schools of nearby tribal areas where school dropout tribal students will be motivated to join the school.
7. Sri Bhagbat Prasad Nanda suggested to open soft skill development programme which will enhance the soft skill among the +3 1st year students and boost their confidence to face various competitive examination.

Finally Dr. J.K. Mishra, Coordinator IQAC gave a brief report on the activities done on the basis of the suggestions given by the Hon'ble members in the last IQAC meeting. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. J.K. Mishra.

PROCEEDING OF IQAC MEETING

A meeting of the IQAC with all the members of IQAC was held on Dt. 3/12/18 at 3.30 pm in the new smart room with S.S. Tripathy, Principal in chair. The co-ordinator of RUSA, IDP, career counselling, Academic Bursar and A/C bursar were also invited to the meeting. After a formal welcome speech by the Principal, Dr. J.K. Mishra co-ordinator, IQAC informed the august house about the different programmes that took place till date for the benefit of the students and the institution. Then as per the request of the chairperson, Madam Tripathy, Co-ordinator of RUSA Dr. N.B. Pradhan informed about the progress of extension work of Library Building under the 2nd phase RUSA fund. Then Sri P.M. Behera, co-ordinator IDP apprised the Honourable members about the 1st phase grant received by the institution and the proposal to utilise that under different heads. There after Dr. Subash Chandra Sahu, Co-ordinator career counselling discussed different steps to be taken under the career counselling cell in the academic session 2018-2019 and to utilise the grant of Rs 3 Lacs that the cell has received.

The following matters were discussed in the meeting:

- 1) First of all Dr. Mishra, co-ordinator IQAC discussed the problem of getting Govt. approval to enhance the total sanctioned strength of Arts and Science stream in accordance with the already sanctioned Hons. seats of different subjects. He also pointed out the problem facing by the institution in furnishing the furniture in the newly constructed building and reviving the already installed internet facility. He also sought co-operation and suggestions from the esteemed guest members to resolve the problems.
- 2) Dr. S.K. Dash, honourable member IQAC suggested to organise a interdisciplinary National/State level seminar and to conduct student academic activities like Quiz, debate and essay. He also stressed on sports activities and requested the principal to put the Gymnasium in a working condition. Further he requested the principal to display Odia signboard for the college and to take necessary steps for solar energy facility for the hostels. He also stressed the need for campus and room cleaning regularly.
- 3) Dr. D. Pattanaik in her speech praised the principal and the staff members for making the institution a complaint free one. She suggested to provide the students sufficient napkin disposal machine and to arrange meetings as much as possible with the citizen, students and staff for interaction to enhance institutional development.
- 4) Sri Raghunath Mishra, another member of IQAC suggested to start immediately the communication skill programme for the students by the career counselling cell for their career guidance. He also requested the principal to take necessary steps to invite some of the nearby Industry officials for campus selection. Finally he suggested to produce the compliance report of today's suggestion in the next IQAC meeting.
- 5) Finally Dr. Kamdeb Sahu suggested to project the mission, vision etc of the college in the college website and to take necessary steps for library automation, e-management of students & employees as these are very important for IDP. He also discussed the motto of IDP. At last the august house decided and requested Dr. K Sahu to discuss in details the importance of IDP in the next IQAC meeting.
