Dt. 24.09.2022: The Induction Programme of +2 Science, Arts, commerce and Vocational Streams

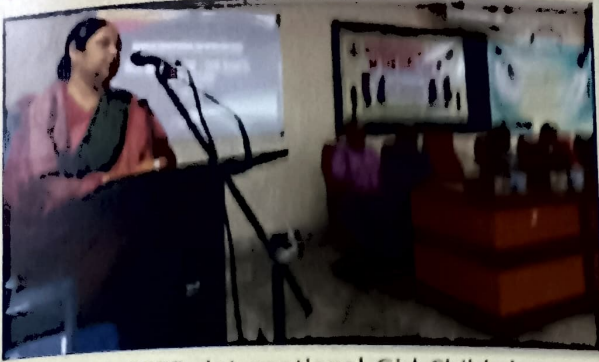
